Trey Gunn, *Quodia* (In performance at EMP Sky Church)

In this workshop, Trey Gunn presents portions of *Quodia* and discusses the original creative vision for the project, how it began and how it evolved, its current state and its future, and how it fits in with his body of work. *Quodia* is a multimedia storytelling/ performance project established by Trey Gunn (of King Crimson) and Joe Mendelson (of Rise Robots Rise) in 2003. This project combines music, film, sound and visual design, literature, and theater into an elegantly layered, immersive performance experience. Part movie, part theater, and part concert, *Quodia* tells archetypal fairy tales, driven by high-tech digital tools—laptops, keyboard, electronic percussion, Warr guitar, video projectors, and a large screen. *Quodia* inspires a degree of audience participation through intentional use of narrative “holes”, where audience members are encouraged to use their own imagination. *There is no processing fee for this workshop.*
